


3. Trivia

- PLAGAL - Cadence based on the progression I-IV-I.
- ELECTRIC BOAT COMPANY - Company that built the first nuclear submarine.
- WIDOW - In Pinochle, name for the three cards dealt face down on the table.

- HASENPFEFFER - German bidding form of Euchre.
- PARECE JAMES - Name of microwave equipment company on Tremont.
- UNDERGRAVEL - Type of aquarium filter that uses a gravel vacuum.
