
Overall Structure











Median Puzzle Solve Time (by Round)




Median Puzzles Solved in Meta when Meta is solved




Median Solve Time (longest, by Puzzle)




Median Solve Time (shortest, by Puzzle)










Time Between DELTA and ECHO (Minutes)

Frumious Bandersnatch Proving the Meta-Existence of the Quasi-Jabberwocky via Subjective Ungravity Spheroids
