Obstacles

- **No clear and good definition of S(WS)**
 - Not really helpful are proposals like
 - $S(WS) = WS + RDF$
 - $S(WS) = \text{workflow management} ++$
 - $S(WS) = [\text{your current web services prototype}]$
- **Ignored experience in a field that already exists for over 30 years**
 - Don't tell me to reveal my internal process for you to determine my behavior!
- **Idea that S(WS) is all about composition and message type matching; it's not!**

Attraction
