The numbers below are based on recent shows. The producer has a total of \$4000.00 to budget and will not reimburse those who go over-budget. You may not "borrow" from anyone else's budget.

**Lighting – \$300.00** We rent instruments from Mike Bromberg of Three Ring Circuits. He charges MITG&SP very reasonable rates.

Set - \$1000.00 Pinafore is a one set show.

**Licenses – \$300.00** Performance licenses must be acquired from the City of Cambridge.

Tickets - \$40.00 These are purchased from Alpha Phi Omega (APO).

Costumes - \$800.00 This includes the cost of renting and drycleaning everything.

Makeup - \$100.00 Some of the foundation cakes may need replacement.

**Props** - \$150.00 This includes the cost of all rentals.

**Publicity** – \$200.00 LSC slides for performances, teasers, posters, tents, etc. (Ads in The Tech are free, but sometimes get booted in favor of paying ads).

**Programs – \$0** Programs pay for themselves in advertisements. An ad swap should be arranged with MTG. An ad swap has already been arranged with Larry Stark of theatermirror.com and Community Players.

Music - \$500.00 A bass, snare drum and timpani are rented from MIT Music.

Strike Party - \$100.00

**Producer's Discretionary Fund – \$510.00** For food (set builds, put-in, strike), parties, miscellany, and emergencies.
