1 General Responsibilities

According to our club Bylaws, a Member at Large “shall become as involved as possible in club affairs.”

As a Member at Large, you should follow the discussions on the officers’ mailing list and look for ways to be helpful. This includes: volunteering for weekly jobs, participating in officer meetings, and offering your advice/opinions on the officers’ mailing list.

Members at Large are supposed to get involved with club business and help out where they can. This is often a chance for the officers to get newer members involved in running the club. It’s also an opportunity to round out representation of various social groups within the club.
