## How to Ride the Birds:

- 1. First, before you create your ride, orient it properly using the key below. If this is your first time, then you are a "first time rider". Make sure the arrows are all pointing up, even if your ride is face down.
- 2. Once you've done that, it's time to assemble your ride!
- 3. Look down at each bird from above with the wings close together. Rotate your bird so that the line beneath the small grid diagram is on the bottom.
- 4. Don't cut even if someone tells you to. Lines for these rides go fast.
- 5. Need inspiration? Video is generally better than pictures.
- 6. Feel like riding again? Reset your ride and go back to step 1! You are now no longer a first time rider.
- 7. Last tip: Print at 100% scale.
- 8. You're all set. Enjoy the rides!
